7 week courses to gain full College credit

**Level one:            INTV1005**

Communication II

This course will examine areas related to congenital deafblindness and emergent communicators. The focus of the course will be on the impact a combined loss of vision and hearing from birth has on an individual, and the role intervention plays in compensating for that loss of vision and hearing. Areas of study will include; what is deafblindness, the impact of deafblindness on the acquisition of information, the primary causes of congenital deafblindness, the philosophy of intervention, the role of the intervenor and the methods and techniques utilized to compensate for the loss of vision and hearing.

**Level three:            INTV2004**

Communication II

This course will examine the impact congenital deafblindness has on conceptual development as well as the difference between skills and concepts. Strategies to teach concepts and to measure an individuals understanding of those concepts will be addressed. The development of materials to aid in teaching concepts that meet the specific needs and learning styles of individuals who are congenitally deafblind will be a focus of this course. Identifying the possible reasons why challenging behaviour might occur as well as the strategies to effectively alleviate or minimize those behaviours will be examined along with vocabulary from Manually Coded English systems
